Position: Full-Time Pre-Licensed Therapist

The Nashville OCD & Anxiety Treatment Center, PLLC, is seeking a full-time Pre-Licensed Therapist to work at our specialty clinic in Brentwood, TN, 10 miles south of Nashville. Candidates must have a master's degree in Counseling or Social Work or a doctoral degree in Psychology and be actively working toward accruing hours toward full licensure. All candidates must have a temporary license in the state of Tennessee (e.g., LMSW, LPC-MHSP temp, or provisional Psychologist license) or be willing to obtain one if offered the position.

We are looking for individuals who work with children, adolescents, and adults and who have experience working with diverse populations. Clinicians who fluently speak a language other than English are encouraged to apply. Individuals need not have prior training in working with OCD but must have a strong foundation in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy and must have an interest in learning about other evidence-based treatments such as Exposure and Response Prevention and Acceptance and Commitment Therapy. The start date for this position is flexible, but we are looking for someone who can begin in August 2021 at the latest. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis with preference given to those who apply by June 15th.

Our center is comprised of a multidisciplinary team of clinicians dedicated to providing effective clinical services and upholding the core values of compassion, creativity, and evidence-based practice. We work with individuals experiencing OCD, anxiety, and related disorders ages five and up. The NOATC provides a supportive environment for therapists who value collaboration over competition and strive for life-long learning. Benefits include an educational stipend for ongoing training and CE attainment; health, dental, and vision benefits; competitive pay; a fully furnished office with administrative services; in-house supervision; ongoing weekly peer consultation; reasonable hours that allow for work-life balance; and a steady referral stream. Ideal candidates will be actively engaged with the local therapy community and will demonstrate excellent case conceptualization and communication skills.
